REQUIREMENTS:

Grade 12 or equivalent certificate that allows registration with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) as a BAA/AEA. Knowledge of Basic / Intermediate Life Support Protocols .A valid Code 10 Drivers license with a valid public driving permit (PDP) for passengers is required. Current registration with HPCSA is required.
