- 1.4 Award the bid to one or more than one bidder/s. The difference in point score should not exceed 10% between the lowest and highest point scorer.
- 2. Quantities are estimates. The actual requirement is based on the need for COVID 19

- (e) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) "functionality" means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) "prices" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) "proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor" means:

  - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
