1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Refer to Part 3 of this invitation to bid for background and introductory information relating to the Goods/Services and this invitation to bid.

2. OFFER AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1 Without detracting from the generality of clause below, bidders must submit a completed and signed Invitation to Bid form (SBD 1) and requisite bid forms attached as <u>Part 5</u>) with its bid. Bidders must take careful note of the special conditions.
- 2.2 All bids submitted in reply to this invitation to bid should incorporate all the forms, parts, certificates and other documentation forming part of this invitation to bid, duly completed where required.
- 2.3 In the event that any form or certificate provided in Part 5 of this invitation to bid does not have adequate space for the bidder to provide the requested details, the bidder should attach an annexure to such form or certificate on which the requested details should be provided and the bidder should refer to such annexure in the form or certificate provided.

3. CLOSING TIME OF BIDS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 3.1 The closing time for the receipt of bids in response to this invitation to bid is detailed on the cover page of this invitation to bid.
- 3.2 All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the bid number, bid description and closing date.

4. ENQUIRIES

5. COMPULSORY BID BRIEFING

The details of the compulsory briefing session are indicated on the cover page of the bid. Bidders will be required to sign the attendance register at the briefing session and obtain an attendance certificate. Bidders who failed to attend or have not signed the attendance register as proof of attendance and do not possess attendance certificate will be disqualified.

PRICING

- 20.1 The information contained in the invitation to bid has been prepared in good faith. 21. COMPETITION

- 21.1 Bidders and their respective officers, employees and agents are prohibited from engaging in any collusive action with respect to the biding process which serves to limit competition amongst bidders.

- 25.2 In terms of Regulation 6 of the Preferential Procurement Regulations pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Act (Act 5 of 2000), responsive bids will be adjudicated by the department on the 80/20- preference points system in terms of which points are awarded to bidders on the basis of:
 - The bid price (maximum 80 points)
 - B-BBEE status level of contributor (maximum 20 points)

The following formula will be used to calculate the points for price:

- 25.3 A bid will not be disqualified from the bidding process if the bidder does not submit a certificate substantiating the B-BBEE status level of contribution or is a non- Compliant contributor. Such bidders will score 0 out of maximum of 20 points for B-BBEE.
- 25.4 Bidders are required to complete the preference claim form (SBD 6.1), and submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof at the closing date and time of the bid in order to claim the B-BBEE status level points.
- 25.5 The points scored by a bidder in respect of the level of B-BBEE contribution will be added to the points scored for price.
- Only bidders who have completed and signed the declaration part of the preference claim form and who have submitted a B-BBEE status level certificate issued by an accredited verification agency will be considered for preference points or Sworn affidavit attested by Commissioner of Oaths in respect of Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) and Qualifying Small Enterprise (QSE).

- 25.8 The total points scored will be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimals.
- 25.9 In the event that two or more bids have scored equal total points, the contract will be awarded to the bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 25.10 However, when functionality is part of evaluation process and two or more bidders have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the contract will be awarded to the bidder scoring the highest functionality.
