- 5. Release letter from supervisors for the employed or serving applicants (18.1).
- 6. Proof of residence as per catchment area one has applied for.
- 7. A certified copy of South African Pharmacy Council Basic Pharmacist Assistant National Certificate (current and not older than three months)
- 8. A good and outstanding academic performance record during schooling or other forms of training will be an added advantage.
