

PHARMACIST`S ASSISTANT (LEARNER POST BASIC) PROGRAMME

The Department has 80 Pharmacist Assistant (Learner Post Basic) Internship opportunities.

3. Proof of registration with the South African Pharmacy Council as a Basic Pharmacist Assistant
4. Certified Copy of Identity document (RSA) – current and not older than three months. (If a South African Identity card is used copies must be for both sides.)
5. CV/Personal profile
6. Z. 83 form filled (obtainable from any Public Service Department office or facility.)
7. Release letter from the supervisor for the employed or serving applicants (18.1).
8. Proof of residence as per the catchment area one has applied for.
9. A good and outstanding academic performance record during schooling or other forms of training will be an added advantage.
