EC Health Nursing College targeted by scammers

BHISHO – The department wishes to warn members of the public and those interested in pursuing Nursing studies at Lilitha College of Nursing that a scammers is targeting unsuspecting applicants.

This scam has been identified through a fake Facebook page created under the name of the department and a WhatApp group operated by individuals who are purporting to be representing the department, offering potential students a free admission a Lilitha Nursing College.

The Department urges members of the public not to fall victim to this scam promising them to be part of the next intake at Lilitha. Also, people should not pay monies for positions advertised by the Department.

We advise members of the community to ignore the fake page, and we have also noted a cellphone number connected to these scams.

The department is currently working with law enforcement agencies in tracking down these alleged scammers and we would like to implore members of the community to contact their nearest police station or the Presidential hotline 17737 at alternatively our contact center manager, Mr Zandisile Ntlube at 043 711 0400 to report all incidents of fraud and extortion.

People should know that government vacancies and other training opportunities are not for sale.
