#### Stage 4: Price & B-BBEE Points

- 3.1 The PPPFA point system will be used for this Quote i.e. 80/20 principle. The evaluation criteria will be as follows: Price = 80, B-BBEE status level of contribution 20
- 3.2 In terms of Regulation 5 (2) and 6 (2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded to a SUPPLIER for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 4. A bid will not be disqualified from the bidding process if the bidder does not submit a certificate substantiating the B-BBEE status level of contribution or is a non- Compliant contributor. Such a bidders will score 0 out of maximum of 20 points for B-BBEE.
- 3.4 Bidders are required to complete the preference claim form (SBD 6.1), and submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof at the closing date and time of the bid in order to claim the B-BBEE status level points.
- 3.5 The points scored by a bidder in respect of the level of B-BBEE contribution will be added to the points scored for price.
- Only bidders who have completed and signed the declaration part of the preference claim form and who have submitted a B-BBEE status level certificate issued by a registered auditor, accounting officer (as contemplated in section 60(4) of the close corporation act, 1984) (act no 69 of 1984) or an accredited verification agency will be considered for preference points.



- 3.7 The department may, before a bid is adjudicated or at any time, require a bidder to substantiate claims it has made with regards to preference.
- 3.8 The total points scored will be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimals.
- 3.9 In the event that two or more bids have scored equal total points, the contract will be awarded to the bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.10 However, when functionality is part of evaluation process and two or more bidders have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the contract will be awarded to the bidder scoring the highest functionality.
- 28.11 Should two or more bids equal in all respects, the award shall be decided by drawing of lots.
- 3.12 A contract may, on reasonable and justifiable grounds, be awarded to a bid that did not score the highest number of points

- 2.10 "Firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;

Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EMEs with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
