1. Guidelines

Guidelines on the specifications for perishable foods ensures that only stock or food items that comply with required standards for acceptable guality are received and used in the food service units.

Perishables Foods should be delivered according to specifications for temperature, transportation & delivery times as specified.

All food delivered in terms of the contract should be subject to inspection and approval by the receiving officer at the delivery point.

The procedure concerning the taking and testing of samples of delivered products, as set out in the regulations made in terms of section 15 of the Agricultural Product Standard Act, 1990. Should be complied with.

The Department reserves the right to conduct inspections of the production process, the product and the premises of the supplier without prior notification at any working time during the contract period or prior to entering into a contract. In the event of a deviation being observed, the whole consignment should be rejected.

Food items not listed in the guidelines should be delivered in accordance with normal trade practice.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS GRADE: 1 – GOOD QUALITY

- All products delivered should comply with at least the quality, packing and making requirements for Grade- 1 eggs, as set out in the regulations made in terms of section 15 of the Agricultural Product Standards Act, 1990
- Eggs should be clean and have intact shells
- The shell membrane may be slightly quivery
- Eggs should be free from blood spots, absorbed odours, and any signs of embryo development or mould.

PACKAGNG

- Eggs should be packed together according to size and grade
- Egg size should be Large (L)
- The product name, grade, number of eggs, expiry date and the name & address of manufacture should appear on the exterior of the packaging

TRANSPORTATION

- Eggs must be delivered in a cool closed delivery van/ truck,
- Eggs must be packed in clean crates, free from dust and mouldy particles
- Delivery times should be between 08h00 to 12h45 and 14h00 to 15:30
- Eggs should be delivered once a week every Mondays failure to deliver on this day will result on penalties
- If delivery will be made by subcontractor, awarded supplier should be on site to sign the delivery note

- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

- 4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
